2. Organizers:

The Association for Education through Art, Republic of China and the Association of Formative Art Education for the Republic of China.

3. Eligibility for participants:
schoolchildren aged 6-15.

4. Art Works:

a. Varieties:

Oil paintings, water colors, wood cut prints, pencil sketches, crayon drawings, pastels, collages, etchings, graphic designs, etc.

b. Size:

Within 55cm X 40cm

c. Number:

The number of entries from each participating country is limited to 60, one piece from each child. The following information is requested to be given in English on each entry:

- a) Full name of the child.
- b) Date & place of birth.
- c) Sex and nationality.
- d) Name and address of the school or institution.

5. Deadline:

Entries should reach the Association for Education through Art, Republic of China, no

later than April 25, 2016.

6. Committee of Judges:

Chinese artists, educators, psychologists, and art educators in the Republic of China (Taiwan) will be invited to serve as judges on the committee.

7. Prizes:

According to the recommendation of the Committee of Judges, certificates will be presented to the selected participants whose works exhibit excellence.
